




































Experience

- ASST MANAGEMENT HETIOO POLICE SPACE
- Interactive poster used within the disciplines (roads, sewerage, ...)
- In small groups (2 to 6 people)
- Awareness that products and activities are part of a cycle
- Inventory of owned assets and state of maintenance is not enough
- Importance of an asset management system accepted
- Difference in maturity between disciplines
- Next step: short term implementation program
- Starting with programming per discipline
- Leading to a strategic management plan public space
- Step by step development to level maturity of disciplines and activities
- Leading to more efficient and effective use of means for the inhabitants
